TFWC DISTRICT PAST PRESIDENTS 1902-1960

Texas Federation of Women's Clubs was founded in 1897, joined GFWC in 1899 and by 1902 had devised a system whereby all of the clubs in the great state of Texas could be fairly represented. The state was divided into five districts and each of the five had its own governing body with district presidents serving as Vice Presidents of TFWC.

As the organization grew so did the need for more districts. In 1915 a sixth district was added, followed by a seventh in 1923. With this addition the district presidents no longer served as Vice Presidents of TFWC, but remained members of the Board of Directors.

An eighth district was added in 1936 and in 1960 the state was realigned to include 14 districts bearing the names Alamo, Capitol, Caprock, Heart of Texas, Key, Magnolia, Mesquite, Pioneer, San Jacinto, Santa Rosa, South Texas, Top of Texas, Trinity, and Western.

With the dissolving of Heart of Texas and Santa Rosa Districts in 2004 and 2006, the number of districts in Texas dropped to twelve. A complete listing of district presidents serving after 1960 can be found in the individual district directory pages.



PIONEER DISTRICT PRESIDENT'S SPECIAL PROJECT

The goal of the GFWC Signature Program: Domestic and Sexual Violence and Prevention is to increase awareness of and help prevent the widespread occurrence of domestic abuse in communities across the Nation.

As a former teacher of young children, I feel that domestic abuse observed and/or experienced in the home is a cause of behavior issues being seen more frequently in the classroom. Research teaches us that children model responses to stress in ways they have experienced in their short lives. Classroom behavior issues not only inhibit academic learning when one does not feel safe, but also strongly affects the social development and trust of all of the children involved.

With no doubt, the recent stress from the Covid pandemic has increased the number of domestic violence cases reported. This, in turn, has increased the need for community support for domestic violence shelters.

The Pioneer District Special Project for 2022 -2024 is for district clubs to adopt a domestic violence shelter in their community and to conduct projects to support them in their efforts to assist the victims they serve. Suggested projects are to collect items specifically needed by the shelter such as paper goods, canned items, toiletries, clothing, and other items that we use on a daily basis. Clubs might even consider donating new pajamas or socks and underwear for children and adults. Games, school supplies, stuffed animals, books, and even "Birthday Bags" that contain a cake mix, birthday cake decorations, balloons, and birthday hats to enable the shelter to celebrate a child's birthday are items that could help make a child feel more normal while living in a shelter. A project that raises money to donate to the shelter to help cover their expenses would also be very beneficial.

- 6. A judge's note should be put in each book. Example: Any required items not included on the cover should be mentioned; incorrectly spelled words should be noted; etc.

YEARBOOK CONTENT:

- 1. Content will be judged according to GFWC Texas Yearbook Scorecard.
- 2. All yearbook entries to the contents contest are to be returned to the clubs at the district convention.
- 3. A scorecard with comments showing each book's judging results is to be placed in the inside back cover of each year book.



PURPOSE:

To recognize today's clubwoman for her commitment to Federation and its ideals through involvement in club, district, TFWC and GFWC programs/projects, to recognize her leadership abilities and to honor her for outstanding volunteer service in her community and world.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Nominee must be a member of a PER CAPITA dues paying club, in good standing with TFWC.
- Nominee SHALL NOT be an elected officer of the district.
- Nominee SHALL NOT be a member, elected or appointed, of the TFWC Executive Committee or a Past State President.

ENTRY RULES:

- 1. Each per capita dues paying club, in good standing with TFWC, shall be entitled to ONE nominee.

- 6. DO NOT SEND artwork, press clippings, letters of endorsement or ANY other supporting materials.

AWARD:

- One Outstanding Clubwoman / Volunteer award will be given annually.
- Each District will name ONE recipient. The District winner will be given special recognition at the District Spring Convention.
- District Chairman shall send recipient's complete nomination packet to the GFWC Texas Outstanding Clubwoman Volunteer Chairman along with GFWC Texas Club Level Reporting Entry Sheet by February 20.
- GFWC Texas will award ONE of the District winners the high honor of GFWC Texas Outstanding Clubwoman Volunteer of the Year.
